CONFIRMATION CLASS SCHEDULE

Class 1 – February 2, 2025: Introductions / Parent Meeting After Class

- Orientation and Materials
- Introduction topics:
 - Who is Jesus?
 - Who am I (really)?
 - Who will accept me (really)?
- Homework
 - Write in your journal the favorite Bible passage of one of your parents, grandparents, or mentors. Write 2-3 sentences about why this verse is special to that person.

Class 2 – February 9, 2025: “I Belong to God”

- Sharing time (journals) from last week
- Scripture: 1 Corinthians 6:19-2, 1 Peter 1:18-19
- Catechism Q&A 1-2. Paul’s letter to Timothy (2 Tim)
- Homework
 - From Heidelberg Catechism, write Q&A 1 and 2 in your journal.
 - In your journal, answer the question: how does reading Q1 of the Heidelberg Catechism make you feel?
 - Write down any questions you may have.

Class 3 – February 16, 2025: “I Am a Sinner”

- Sharing Time (Catechism Q&A 1-2)
- Scripture: Romans 3:23, 1 John 1:8
- Catechism Q&A 3-8
- Homework
 - Write Catechism Q&A 6-8 in your journal.
 - In your journal, give an example of your own life that helps you to understand that you are not simply a “good person” but actually inclined towards evil.
 - Write down any questions you may have.

Class 4 – March 2, 2025: “I Have Been Saved From My Sin”

- Sharing Time (Catechism Q&A 6-8)
- Scripture: Romans 5:8
- Catechism Q&A 9-13 and 18
- Homework:
 - Write Catechism Q&A 18 in your journal.
 - Answer in your journal: What characteristics of Jesus as a savior are you

- grateful for? How come?
- Write down any questions you may have.

STUDENT SUNDAY EXPERIENCE – March 9, 2025

- Students will go down to the student space when dismissed and experience the student service with all of the students.
- Homework:
 - In your journal, write down what your main takeaway from the talk was and what your experience was like.

SMALL GROUPS – Wednesday, March 12, 2025, 7-9 PM

- Small Groups was developed when we realized that students were desiring a space to talk openly about questions of faith as well as life struggles. We start the night catching up, playing games, and eating pizza and then transition into a time of studying scripture and personal sharing in groups separated by age and gender.
- If this night does not work for you to attend, please let me know. **Confirmands must attend one Small Groups through Confirmation.**

Class 5 – March 16, 2025: “I have a new life in Christ” / Mentor Get Together

- Sharing Time (Catechism Q&A 18)
- Scripture: Colossians 3:1-4
- Catechism Q&A 39, 40, 43, 45, and 59
- Homework:
 - Write Catechism Q&A 59 in your journal.
 - Write a letter to a friend answering Q59. Should be about ½ page to be handed in next week.
 - Write down any questions you may have.

Class 6 – March 23, 2025: “I Am God’s Masterpiece”

- Sharing Time (Catechism Q&A 59)
- Scripture: Ephesians 2:8-10
- Catechism Q&A 86, 88, 89, 90
- Homework:
 - Write Catechism Q&A 86-90 in your journal.
 - Answer in your journal: What is an example of how you can “die to your old self” in a realistic way?

Class 7 – March 30, 2025: “I Belong to Christ’s Church”

- Sharing Time (Catechism Q&A 86-90)
 - What was writing your letter like?
- Scripture: Acts 2:28, 42-47
- Catechism Q&A 66-68. Sacraments.
- Introduction to Testimony writing.
- Homework:
 - Write Catechism Q&A 66-68 in your journal.

- In your journal, explain one concept from the questions, using a picture, poem, or paragraph.
- Write down any questions you may have.
